

2016 SPRING SOCCER TOURNAMENT RULES

U10 BOYS

Games consist of two 13 minute halves, with a 2-minute break in between.

3 Pools

Pool A: 4 teams

Pool B: 4 teams

Pool C: 3 teams

Win = 3 points

Tie = 1 point

Loss = 0 points

The winner of Pool C (team with the most points in Pool C) will advance to the semi-final game on Saturday. For Pool A and Pool B, the team with the most points between the winners of those pools will advance to the Championship game on Sunday. The other team will advance to the semi-final game on Saturday. The semi-final game has the same modified time rule as above, and the winner will advance to the full length Championship game on Sunday, May 22 at 1:30 p.m.

Tie Breaker: Goals Allowed; if still a tie, then Goals Scored; if still a tie, then a coin-toss.

** If necessary, use the tie-breaker to determine the winners of Pool A and Pool B first. Then, it can be used again if needed to determine the seed for the championship and semi-final games.

U10 GIRLS

Games consist of two 13 minute halves, with a 2-minute break in between.

3 Pools

Pool A: 3 teams

Pool B: 3 teams

Pool C: 3 teams

Win = 3 points

Tie = 1 point

Loss = 0 points

The team with the most points from each pool will win that pool. The pool winner with the most points advances to the Championship game on Sunday. The two remaining teams will play a semi-final game on Saturday with the same modified time rule stated above. The winner of the semi-final game advances to the full length Championship game on Sunday, May 22 at 1:30 p.m.

Tie Breaker: Goals Allowed; if still a tie, then Goals Scored; if still a tie, then a coin-toss.

** If necessary, use the tie-breaker to determine the winners of individual pools first. Then, it can be used again if needed to determine the seeds for the championship and semi-final games.
