The clinic will cover topics from shooting lay-ups to offensive team concepts and team defense. The camp will be divided into two sessions according to the age of the participant. **Camp for boys entering the 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades will be May 30th through June 1st from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. Camp for boys entering the 6th, 7th and 8th grades will be May 30th through June 1st from 11:30 am to 2:00 pm.** Participants should wear gym shorts, tee shirts, white socks, and basketball shoes. The cost of the clinic is \$35.00 per participant. (2 family members \$60.00 and 3 family members \$90.00).
