



Kathy Taylor begins her first season as Le Moyne's head women's lacrosse coach in 2015. In 2014, Taylor led Cortland to a 22-1 record, the program's 16th straight SUNYAC title and the team's fourth straight trip to the NCAA Div. III Final Four. Last season, Cortland had both the Division III Defender and Attacker of the Year for the first time in school history. Taylor was named IWLCA Empire Region Coach of the Year for the fourth consecutive season. Taylor finished her coaching career at Cortland with a combined record of 115-17 (.871). Prior to her college coaching career, Taylor spent 18 years at Fayetteville-Manlius, where she finished with a record of 245-62-3, and won two state championships. "I am extremely grateful and energized for the opportunity that Matt Bassett and Le Moyne College has given me. I am excited about the future of the program and thrilled to come in and continue the great work Beth Hewitt has done in establishing Le Moyne as a national contender. I look forward to working with the outstanding student-athletes and can not wait to get started chasing a national championship."
