Coaching Experience

I began coaching in 2008 where I captained my university team and had to take two training sessions per week, I managed to take my team to promotion. After I finished University I moved to Torquay, in Devon, and gained myself a job working for the sports department in the Torbay council youth work sector. This job required me to become highly involved in sports and my main sport was football where I coached local children who were at risk of offending/re-offending. This job also demanded well organized programs such as tournaments, leagues and travelling to other sports events where the children engaged with other teams from the south west. In 2010 I became a manager for the under twelves local football team where I managed them from 2010 to 2013. My most recent sports position was working for Paignton community & Sports Academy. I worked within the football development department where I took training sessions for the younger years of the academy. I also ran the local football community projects for the school which consisted of a Saturday night seven aside league (ages 15-19), moreover I supervised a Friday night social inclusion session for local children of all ages. This job also required me to run the school gym several times per week.
