HOW TO KEEP SCORE

Set up the scorecard with the names, numbers and positions of the starting lineup for each team.

Each time a batter goes to the plate, use the number or symbol to show how he reached base or was retired.

Track the bases reached by the runners and shade the diamond for when each run is scored.

As new players enter the game, add them into their respective place in the lineup.
