

VOTE “YES” ON ARTICLE 32 – TO SAVE WOLF SWAMP FIELDS!!!!

Attention Town Residents: Save May 10th and possibly May 11th - just in case. We all need to come together and **VOTE “YES”** on Article 32 at the upcoming Town Meeting on Tuesday, May 10. However, the Town Moderator has said that the meeting could be split into two nights if not all Articles can be discussed and voted on in one night. This decision will be made at the May 10 meeting. Save May 10th and 11th - just in case! This is the last article on the town warrant.

Here’s why Article 32 is important:

- Are you aware that the Town is looking at possibly building a **five-acre** DPW facility on the Wolf Swamp Fields?
- Can you imagine an “industrial type” facility – with large trucks and equipment, high security fences, expansive paved areas, fuel storage and dispensing tanks, exposed bulk materials and huge salt sheds – being placed within what is now a beautiful, open area of fields, conservation land, the Field Club and Twin Hills CC?
- Do you know that the **deed** for the Wolf Swamp Fields states the land is to be “held for recreational purposes” – but Town officials say there is a way to “get around this” – so the Select Board does not have to honor the deed?
- Do you know that the **town warrant language**, approved by Longmeadow voters to buy the Fields, also stated that “said land should be used for-recreation purposes” – but Town officials say there is a way to get around that as well – again so the Select Board does not have to honor the voters’ wishes?

You can stop this from happening!!!

A **“YES”** vote on Article 32 at Town Meeting on Tuesday, May 10, or possibly My 11, will send a loud and strong message to our Town officials that we want to **SAVE THE WOLF SWAMP FIELDS** and will not accept a DPW facility.

We know it may be a very long night on May 10, or possibly May 11th, as Article 32 is the last Article to be discussed. But we ask that you please stay if at all possible and let your Town officials know how you feel on this issue.
