COVID-19 SAFETY OFFICER

- Communicate COVID-19 Policy and Return to Soccer Activities Guidelines organization wide - Coaches, Parents, Players.
- Assist in assigning each team a COVID-19 Coordinator to oversee compliance at the team level (can be a team parent who must register as an Adult with Mass Youth Soccer).



COVID-19 SAFETY OFFICER

- Train and educate all volunteers/staff on return to soccer activities protocols. Using guidelines and tools from MA Youth website.
- Develop a relationship and dialogue with local Health Department officials (identify their risk tolerance).
- Develop a plan to communicate with the local health department in the event of a confirmed case of COVID-19 within a team.



Team COVID-19 Coordinator

- Coach/Assistant Coach may take on this role. It is recommended that there at least 2 rostered coaches for a team if a coach plans to take on role of COVID Coordinator
- Parent from team (must be registered with MA Youth Soccer)



Team COVID-19 Coordinator

- Communicates COVID-19 policies with team (masks, balls, hand sanitizer, social distancing)
- Keeps accurate attendance records for practices and games. Necessary for contact tracing.
- Monitors sidelines to ensure COVID-19 policies (physical distancing, masks) are being followed.



PPE

- Basics
 - Face Coverings and Masks
 - Disinfectant Wipes or Disinfectant spray/paper towel
 - Sanitizer
- Optional
 - Gloves

Taking Temperatures

- Parents are to self-certify that their child illness free. If child's temperature is over 100.4 the child should not attend the session.
- A parent is responsible for taking temperature, not the coach.
- Do not retain any personal medical information about a child as this may violate Health Information Privacy policies.



COACH IS THE KEY

- Coaches, with support of club Covid-19 Safety Officer and Team Coordinator **must**:
 - Understand, implement, follow and support all guidelines.
 - Must set an example for players, parents, spectators, referee.
 - Must maintain 6 to 10 feet of distancing at all times.
 - Must practice proper hygiene and sanitization practices.



What if a member of our organization contracts COVID-19?

- Affected individual or parent should contact the President and Covid-19 Safety Officer who then contacts local DPH.
- Department of Public Health will provide the individual with instructions on what to do.
- All Parties who have had close contact with the individual should be notified using the COVID diagnosis notification form, found in the resource section of the Return to soccer activities page of MA Youth Soccer website. **Be careful not to disclose the individuals name.**



What if a member of our organization contracts COVID-19? (cont.)

- A **close contact** is someone with whom you have been within 6 feet of for at least 10-15 minutes while symptomatic or within 48 hours before symptom onset. A close contact can also be someone who had direct contact with the droplets of a COVID-19 case (e.g., being coughed on) while not wearing a mask or face coverings.
- All teams and individuals that have come in close contact with the individual will have soccer activities suspended for 14 days.



What if a member of our organization contracts COVID-19? (cont.)

- Be prepared to provide local health officials with information regarding those who have had close contact with the individual. Accurate attendance for each session is important.



Adherence

- Mass Youth Soccer's website page: ***Return to Soccer Activities.***
- It is imperative that we follow the guidelines as required by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
- Identify your organization's COVID Safety Officer.
- Each team should have a COVID Coordinator.
- All coaches, volunteers and employees must read, understand and practice the guideline requirements.
- This is a group effort that requires a collective focus.
