Hello All,

You are receiving this because you are an active volunteer with Shrewsbury Youth Soccer. As the Fall soccer season is rapidly approaching, it is time to make sure that you are **registered with Mass Youth Soccer** and that your **CORI status is valid**.

As many of you may know, Mass Youth Soccer requires all volunteers (coaches, team

parents, board members, etc.) to register with the organization **every year**. This account will also keep track of your CORI status and will inform you when your CORI is nearing its expiration date.

As of today, **you are not registered with Mass Youth Soccer**. You must complete this as soon as possible. It only takes a few minutes and **MUST BE DONE** prior to the start of the soccer season. The instructions are below.

Important notes for Adult Registration...

- If you registered with Mass Youth Soccer in the last year, you are a **RETURNING USER**. You will be required to verify your current information.
- If you have not registered with Mass Youth Soccer, you are a **NEW USER**, in which case you will be
 - **required to upload a head shot photo** of yourself so make sure there is one available on your computer, phone, etc.
 - Please use your **full legal first and last name** (no shortened version) when completing the registration.
 - Please **double check when choosing your organization(s)** for your Adult Registration. Be sure to enter "*Shrewsbury Youth Soccer*" as well as any other Massachusetts soccer organization that you belong to.

After you register with Mass Youth soccer **you will receive an email** from them. The email contains your CORI expiration date and the link to complete the CORI portion *if necessary*. If you don't receive it, please check your **junk/spam folder**. The complete instructions are below.

- Go to the following link http://www.mayouthsoccer.org/members/adult_registration/
 - Click the Adult registration link.
 - Select either "Returning User" if you registered with Mass Youth Soccer in the past year or "New User" if you haven't registered in the past. Remember, new users will need to **upload a head shot** during the registration.
 - After you register with Mass Youth Soccer, **you will receive an email**. This will confirm your registration and give you your CORI expiration date. If your CORI needs to be updated, a link will be provided to complete the CORI registration. If you don't receive this email, please **check your spam/junk email**.
- If a CORI check is necessary...

- Go to the link **PROVIDED IN THE EMAIL** and follow the instructions.*Please note that the link provided is specific to you and is the only way to complete the CORI check.*
- After you complete the CORI check, you will be asked to **print a validation document**.
- Please print, sign and forward it to me. I need to have this document so that I can confirm that your CORI has been processed. You can either scan the signed document or take a picture of it and email it to me.

If your CORI expiration date is still valid, your registration is complete. Keep in mind that you will need to update your Mass Youth Soccer registration on an annual basis.
