Summary of the Basics and FAQ

1. 100% Masks

Approved Face Masks, at ALL times, while at the Field (on and off the pitch) by EVERYONE. Players, Coaches and Spectators. **Players Masks must be ear loop masks ONLY.**

2. Maintain Social Distance

Players on the sidelines maintain 6' spacing, have their own water, PPE...
Spectators minimum 8' from the Field and maintain a minimum of 6' from each family group
Town of Shrewsbury Limit (2) Spectators + Siblings

3. Recommend hand/equipment sanitizing before and after practice/game, other...

DO NOT share water, pinnies, goalie gloves

4. Have Attendance for every Practice/Game

This information is to be used to establish contact tracing in the event of a positive COVID-19

5. Stay home/go home if not feeling well

Minimize group/population contact. Arrive 15 min before designated practice/game time;
Leave within 15 minutes of scheduled completion

6. Report any cases of COVID-19 to AGC Immediately
