The above-named incorporator(s) do hereby associate (themselves) with the intention of forming a corporation under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 180 and hereby state(s):

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

SPENCER SOCCER ASSOCIATION, INC.

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed is as follows:

The association is organized to provide the physical, mental and character development of boys and girls, men and women, by providing an organized program of soccer training and competition and by providing such other means of recreation, training, education and guidance as, in the judgement of the directors, will achieve these purposes.

To raise through solicitation or otherwise, collect and receive funds and bequests, and to administer such funds and bequests for its purposes.

To purchase, hold, lease, mortgage and convey such real and personal property as may be necessary or incidental to the purposes of the corporation; to receive and hold and administer gifts of property real, personal and mixed, and, generally to do such lawful acts and carry out all lawful purposes as are now permitted by general laws or may be permitted by amendments thereof or any addition thereto.

3. If the corporation has more than one class of members, the designation of such classes, the manner of election or appointment, the duration of membership and the qualification and rights, including voting rights, of the members of each class, are as follows: -

Class #1 - Persons certified by the Registrar of the Corporation to be coaches, managers, league officers and players in good standing of soccer teams affiliated with the Corporation as of the date of the adoption of the By Laws. Only players of legal voting age may vote at all meetings of the Corporation. Such coaches, managers, officers and players so certified at the Annual Meeting of the Corporation or any Special Meeting held in lieu thereof.

Class #2 - Persons other than coaches, managers, officers and players who, after the date of adoption of the By Laws, are elected members by a majority vote of those present at any meeting of the Corporation at which a quorum is present.

- *4. Other lawful provisions, if any, for the conduct and regulation of the business and affairs of the corporation, for its voluntary dissolution, or for limiting, defining, or regulating the powers of the corporation, or of its directors or members, or of any class of members, are as follows:-

5. By-laws of the corporation have been duly adopted and the initial directors, president, treasurer and clerk or other presiding, financial or recording officers whose names are set out below, have been duly elected.
6. The effective date of organization of the corporation shall be the date of filing with the Secretary of the Commonwealth or if later date is desired, specify date, (not more than 30 days after date of filing).
7. The following information shall not for any purpose be treated as a permanent part of the Articles of Organization of the corporation.
