

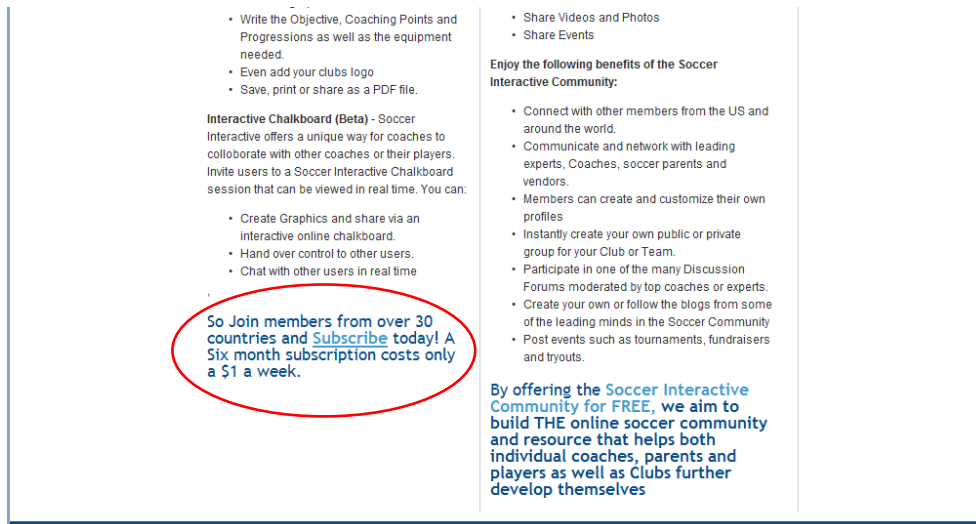


Instructions for Accessing SoccerPlus Curriculum Activities

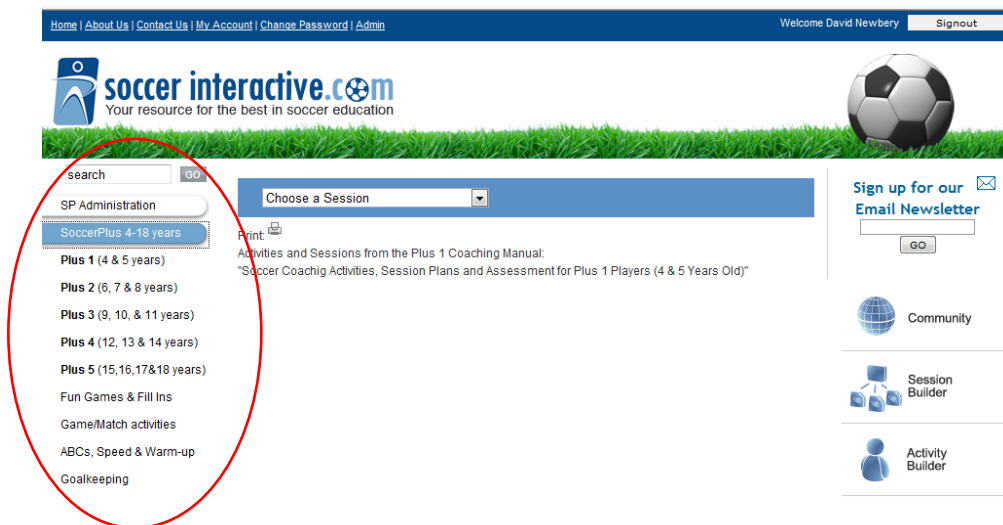

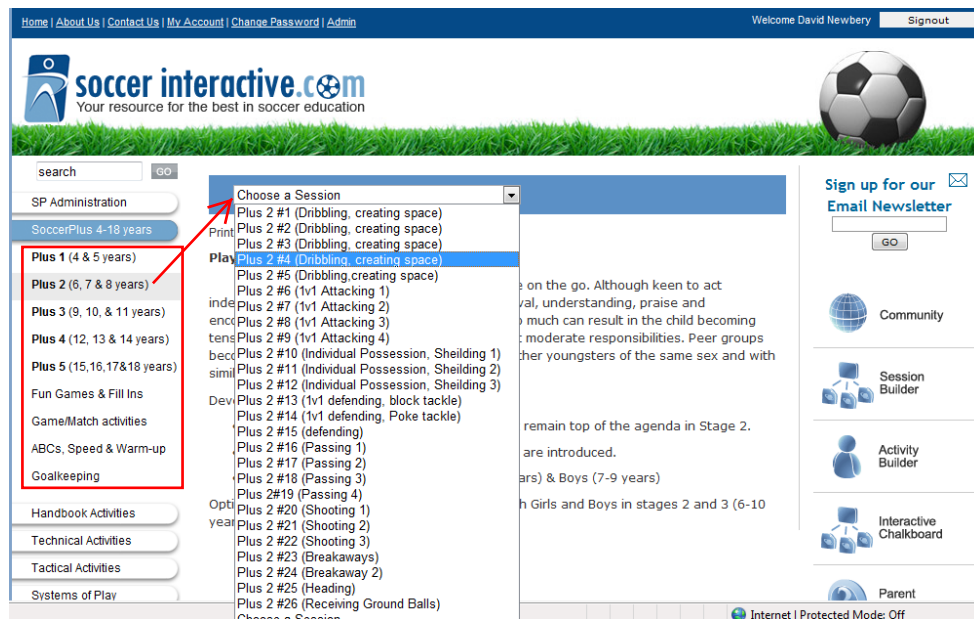

7. Select the most relevant curriculum based on development stage (Plus 1 – Plus 5) and select the session plan you wish to view



8. Select one of the 4 activities in the session plan you have selected. If the session has a video the screen will default to the video (1). You can also select the illustration (2).

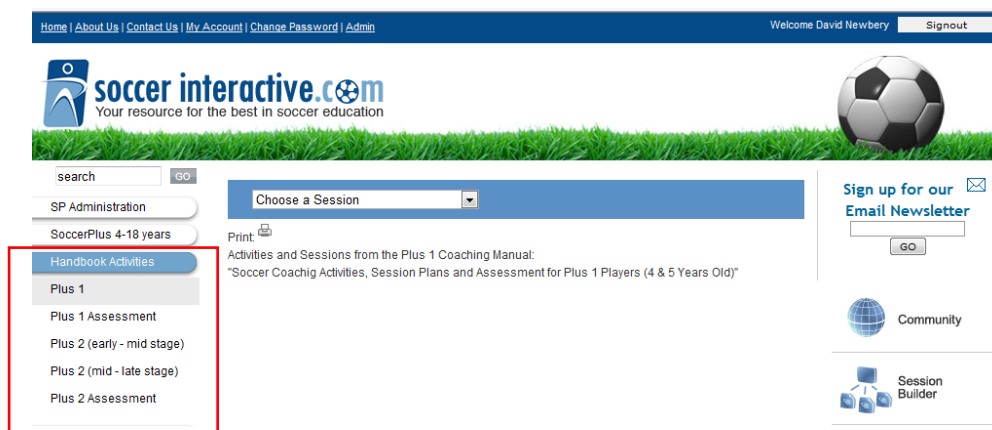
10. When you return to the site you will need to type your username and password (1) and select coaching education (2).

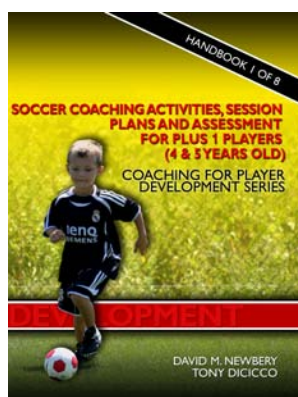

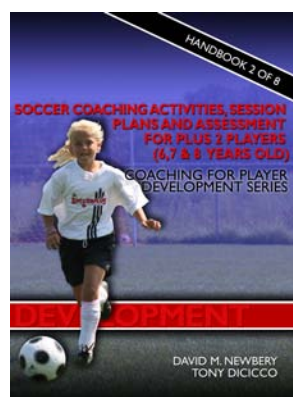
