

Wakefield United GU14 Season Overview: 2015-2016



Wakefield United GU14 Commitment:

Training: One day per week.

Training will start the week of August 24th, 2015 and continue through the fall season.

Indoor winter training will consist of: 4 pre-spring season trainings the month of March

2016: typically Friday's immediately following the end of the school day:
Americal Civic Center: 3-4:30pm. Players can walk over to the Civic Center right after school.

Games: Fall 2015 season starts: September 13, 2015, with no games on October 11, 2015 (Columbus Day), and runs for 9 weeks. These games are typically scheduled Sunday afternoon at and/or after 1pm. Games will be a combination of home games and away games. Expect away games to be within a 1hour 15minute drive. Mid-week make up games cannot be ruled out.

Games: Spring 2016 season starts: April 5, 2016, which consists of 7 games. No games scheduled for Memorial Day, plan to participate in a Memorial Day Tournament, which could be as far as 1 hour commute. Expect a Maple tournament the second week of June, 2015, typically at Mass. Youth Soccer Headquarters, Lancaster, Ma.

We also, have a few last minute special events which do come up. For example: invitations to play in special events and special training sessions and friendly matches. All of which are to expand upon the player's experience.

Tuition for the GU14 program is: \$469 per player. Payment due, upon team placement.

This includes:

Uniform: \$250/pp: Home and Away Jersey, Shorts, Socks, Warm up Jacket and Pants and Backpack.

Fall 2015 and spring 2016 Maple registration fees: \$114/pp: 9 games in the fall and 7 games in the spring.

Indoor winter training and tournament fees: \$105/pp
