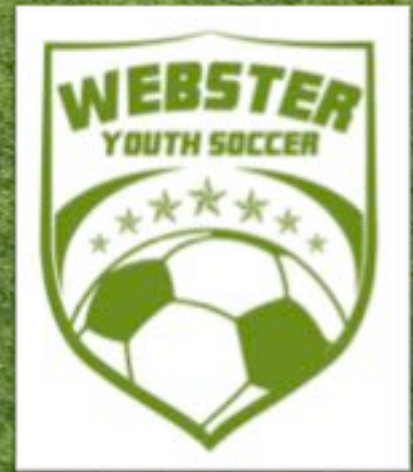

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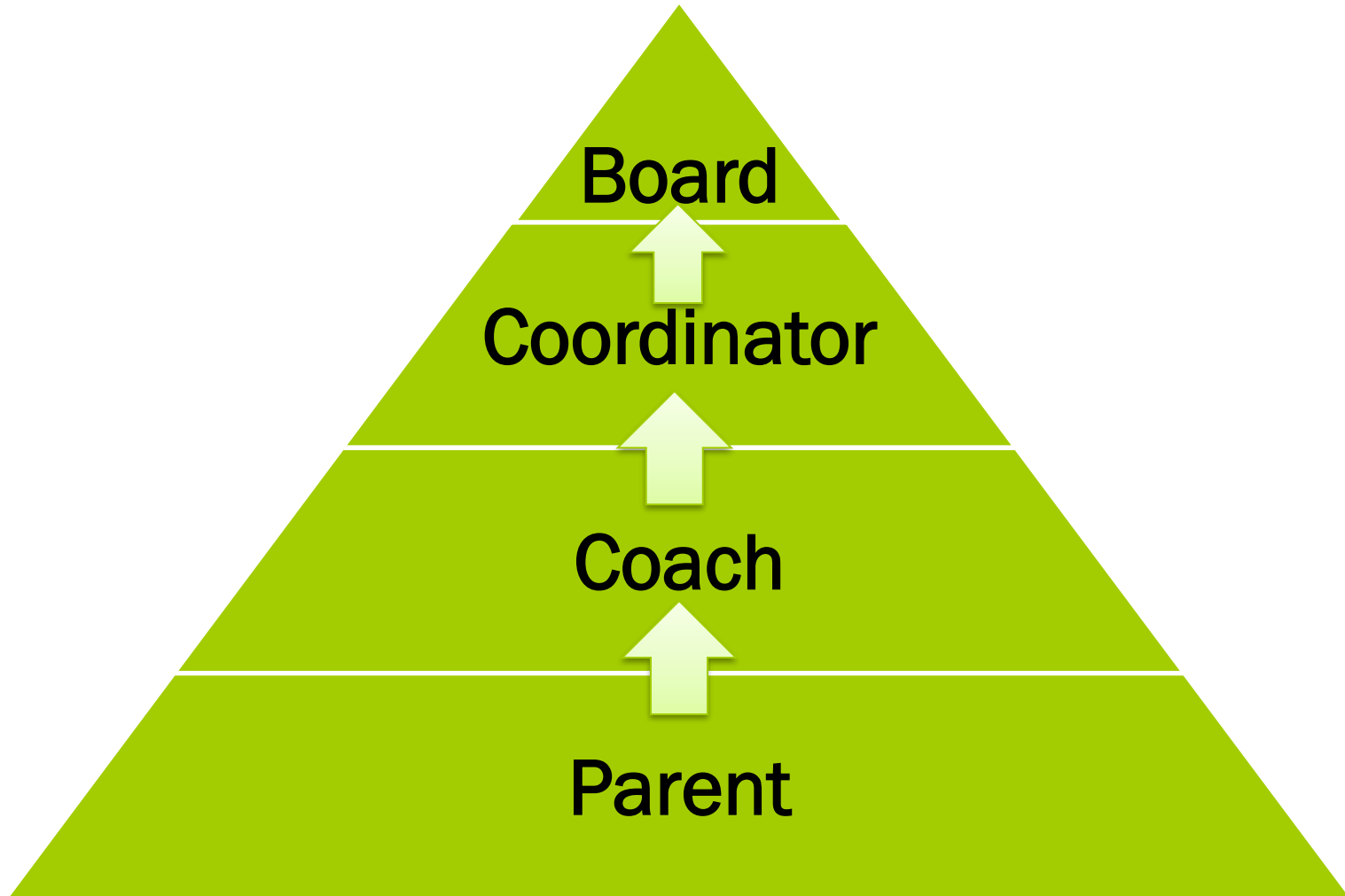

Mass Youth Soccer Requirements

- **Adult Registration**

- All volunteers associated with Webster Youth Soccer
- Adults 18 years or older
- Annual requirement (9/1 to 8/31)
- Needed regardless of CORI status
- Full Legal name
- Head shot photo required
- Select correct affiliated organization (Webster Youth Soccer)

- **Cori Submissions & Clearance**

- Needed for adults 18 years or older with direct & unmonitored access to children
- Second step in registration process
- Must be "CORI cleared" (submit, results reviewed & clearance to participate-
- CORI Acknowledgement Form required/Driver License verification

- **Adult Credentials**

- Starting Fall 2016 – Soft Rollout
- Lanyard need to be worn work in official member activities (coaching, lining fields, board members)

Referee Overview

- In-Town Escalation



- MAYS Zero Tolerance Policy

- Coaches & Spectators must support the referee
- Coaches are responsible for players & spectators
- No one is to address the referee during match
- Exceptions during the game / end of game for coaches
- Penalties, suspensions & forfeitures



Parent Meeting & Field Info

- **Parent Meeting**



- Conduct meeting either before or after first practice to:
 - Set expectations
 - Review Code of Conduct (acknowledged during registration & published on website)
 - Advise on League (WYS & MAYS) Policies/Rules

- **Field Information**

- Must have Field Permit in possession
- Dogs not allowed on field
- Locking/unlocking bathrooms for practices & games
- Spectators on “parent side” & not allowed on end lines
- Ensure sandbags are on goals

Running Up Scores

- **Mismatched Game Strategies:**
 - 10 passes before taking a shot
 - Players must use weaker foot
 - Every player must touch the ball in a possession before a shot
 - Can only score in certain situation - from a cross/a header/a volley
 - Changing the number of players on the field - adding 1 to the weaker team, or taking 1 off the stronger team (talk to the opposing coach about this first)
 - Challenge your team to just keep possession once the score reaches a 5 goal differential (5-0, 6-1, etc)
 - Give players targets related to what you've worked on in practice e.g. "x number of give & gos" or "y number of 1v1 moves per player" so this becomes their focus in the game instead of scoring.
- **MAYS Policy**
 - Any team with a differential score of 8 or more goals:
 - First Offense: Warning
 - Second Offense: Coach suspended for one game & WYS town fined \$150
 - Next occurrence: Coach suspended for eight (8) games & WYS fined \$150
