Try Out Process:

- 1. Please show up 15-30 minutes early to check in for try-outs. Lines will be long as we have over 300 players in the fall season. All players will be assigned a “try out” number. Try Out numbers can be picked up on the first night of tryouts at check in. Please bring your own safety pins. Pin the number on the back of your shirt. The club prohibits any WSC or Premier jerseys from being worn at tryouts. Your child will be asked to change out of these shirts. It’s your responsibility to wear your number for the second night of tryouts.**
- 2. The formation of teams will be completed sometime in early July. Once coaches have been decided the placement of your child will be revealed. The club MAY send out important information via e-mail through the online registration if there are any changes. Please DO NOT CALL or EMAIL the registrar to find out your child’s placement.**
- 3. In the event a player cannot be placed on a team due to insufficient player numbers in an age group, the family will be contacted by a club official to review the situation and explain the options. These may include refunds, playing up an age group, or assisting with placement on another club in the Pioneer Valley Junior Soccer League.**
- 4. With the new requirements there are a maximum number of spots available on a team roster. The roster spots are similar to last year and all players that miss tryouts will be placed on a waiting list and slotted after those attending are placed. It is strongly encouraged that all players attend two tryout nights. Failure to do so will have an impact on your players overall score and may impact where they are placed.**
- 5. All parents must remain on the bridge or under the pavilion for the entire tryout. This will be reinforced by the staff and no coaching from the sidelines will be permitted during tryouts. This is for the benefit of the children.**
